Meeting Notes

<u>1. Orchestra</u>

<u>-Winter Concert</u> Notes from Ms. Lewis: I will need help with the dress rehearsal on the 18th and the concert happening on the 19th. For the rehearsal, I could use help keeping the crowd quiet while we are rehearsing. They are not allowed to eat in the auditorium!

For the concert, we will try to sell hot cocoa and cookies. Autumn is taking care of that, but she may need help. If anyone is available, that would be great. We also need to make sure people with food and drinks are not entering the auditorium. There will be an intermission so we can reset the stage. This will be another good time to sell the items.

There will be 2 concerts on the same day (4 and 7pm). Students will stay at school the entire day! I will need parents to help chaperone mainly during the second concert when students are going to sit in the orchestra room and not watch the concert. I

<u>Action Items</u>

<u>1. Orchestra</u>

Winter Concert: Jean Marie and Ravisha will sell tickets at the winter concert, and Autumn will run the cookie and cocoa table; Ravisha will bring the Showtix chart for seating; Ms. Poppe will help vacate the auditorium after each show; Christy will work the cash box for art sales from 5pm until the concert starts. am sending a sign-up sheet to the parents about that today.

Autumn will arrange the cookie and cocoa sale for intermission during the first show, the break in between shows, and intermission during the second show, until sold out. She's planning on 200 hot cocoa packets (mixed at the concert) and 400 cookies, and asking for the cocoa to be donated. Each item \$1.

Separate cash boxes needed for ticket sales (chorus) and snacks sales (FAB).

A sign-up genius has been created for soliciting parent helpers and donations of cocoa and supplies.

<u>-Davis Drive Recruitment Trip</u> Notes from Ms. Lewis: On the 20th, we are going to Davis Drive for a recruitment performance. I will also need chaperones for that. I know it's the last day of school before break so not many people may be available. We will be loading instruments at 8:15 and leaving soon after that. I need help with crowd control since I will need to set up the stage etc.

2. Fine Arts

<u>-NAHS</u> The National Art Honor Society students painted the Athletic Boosters squares in the stadium area. They are hoping to receive the check (over \$700) for that soon to pay for Scholastic entries.

The NAHS is also selling artwork before the band and orchestra/chorus concerts this and

next week. They will need a cash box for this Thursday.

-<u>Upcoming Shows</u> There are multiple shows coming up in January, and throughout spring. They will use the FAB card for preparations for Scholastics.

<u>-A Field Trip</u> to an art museum is in the works.

-<u>The Art Club</u> co-presidents are eager to be active alongside NAHS.

<u>3. Theatre</u>

-States went well.

<u>-Theatre</u> is currently between shows; auditions for *9 to 5 The Musical* will begin after winter break; the rights have been purchased; Jess will do choreography; David Cole will do piano.

<u>-ITS Festival</u>-some students will participate in individual events at \$15 pp, paying for themselves.

<u>-A collaboration with Visual Arts</u> 4th period students is underway, where theatre students create shorts based on art by the visual artists.
